

## COMPLAINT PROCEDURES FOR FEDERALLY FUNDED PROGRAMS

Any organization or individual who believes that the School District of Monroe is in violation of a federal statute or regulation that applies to federally funded programs may file a complaint with the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction. The complaint must be in writing, signed, and include a statement that the District has violated a requirement of the federal statute or regulation and the facts upon which this allegation is based. A decision on the complaint will be made within 60 days after the DPI receives the complaint. An independent on-site investigation may be conducted to resolve the complaint.
